Reap What is Sown

Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-7 & Matthew 6:20-21

Christ spoke of our "treasures in Heaven." We can't take our possessions there with us, so the possessions here don't matter. Again, "it's the state of your heart." "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." If your treasure is money here on earth, that's where your heart is. And, "the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows" (1 Timothy 6:10). That's not where you want your heart. We're not espousing a prosperity gospel, but God has promised to bless His people. If you're His, what blessings have you received? To paraphrase Paul, those who sow bountifully will reap bountifully, but those who sow sparingly will reap sparingly. Reaping what you sow isn't just about money. Sometimes, the car goes farther, the appliances last longer, the family grows bigger, your health stays stronger. Many intangibles we forget to count as blessings. Malachi 3:10 says we can have more blessings than we can receive. When you have truly surrendered to Christ as Lord of your life, the Holy Spirit will guide you. He will use you for His Kingdom! What is greater than that? He has great plans in your life! You just have to let Him take control!
